

On their Team visit to SMBB Institute of Trauma Karachi, the Emergency Department (Dr. Azer, Dr. Beenish and Dr. Qurrat) and the Executive Director Dr. M. Sabir Memon had a detailed discussion on the needs of people requiring definitive trauma and emergency treatment.

SERS Team had a tour of the Emergency Department, Triage, Trauma Bays and HDU and were impressed by the management of immense trauma management workload.

These visits are extremely important and will result in integration of the different faculties which are working in emergency care under the Health Department of the Government of Sindh with the moto of, "Commitment to Serve Sindh and the Entire Nation."



The four basic concepts of learning theory i.e. motivation, reinforcement, retention and transference were addressed. SMBB Institute of Trauma Karachi Organizes Successful Awareness Walk!

On 22 September 2024, the Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto Institute of Trauma Karachi (SMBBIT) organized an impactful awareness walk to promote road safety and accident prevention. The event saw enthusiastic participation from SMBBIT employees, officers from various departments, and the support of **DIG Sindh Traffic, Mr. Ahmed Nawaz Cheema.** Sindh Traffic Police mobilized cars, motorcycles, and personnel, including women officers, to be part of this important initiative.

The walk also included teams from Sindh Emergency Rescue Service (1122) and **Sindh Integrated Emergency Health Service, along with the Pakistan Life Saver Program.** Both male and female staff members actively participated in the event, demonstrating a unified commitment to road safety.

The awareness walk began at Dow University Karachi Main Campus and concluded at **SMBB Institute of Trauma Karachi**, with participants holding banners and placards carrying crucial safety messages such as:

- Accidents can be avoided with a few simple precautions.
- Use helmets and seat belts to protect yourself and others.
- Women should ensure their clothing is secure while riding.
- Teach children to cross roads safely and face traffic while walking.

After the walk, a seminar was held to emphasize the importance of preventing road accidents. It was highlighted that road traffic injuries are a leading cause of death and disability, particularly in low-income countries where motorcycles are a common means of transportation. By following traffic rules and using safety gear like helmets, many accidents, injuries, and fatalities can be prevented.

An accident victim shared his personal story of how a motorcycle accident left him severely injured and hospitalized for an extended period, underscoring the urgent need for road safety awareness.

Sindh Traffic Officials, Sindh Emergency Rescue Service (1122), Sindh Integrated Emergency Health Service, and the Pakistan Lifesaver Program team discussed the importance of awareness and safety measures.

SMBBIT Executive Director, Dr. Sabir Memon, spoke about the increasing workload at the trauma center and the essential services it provides. The special guest, Mr. Usman Ghani Hingoro, Special Assistant to Chief Minister of Sindh, emphasized the need to follow traffic rules and wear helmets. He also praised the initiative and stressed the importance of ongoing awareness programs on safety and accident prevention.

Dr. Sabir Memon expressed his gratitude to Mr. Usman Ghani Hingoro and the participants, presenting a shield to Mr. Usman and souvenirs to other esteemed guests. The event concluded with refreshments for all attendees.
